

On the occasion of the Rettoria's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary, an interfaith room – prompted by Università Bocconi – was opened on 30 May 2012, available to all non-Christian Bocconi people (Hebrews, Muslims, Hinduists, etc.) wishing to have a place where they may stay for readings and prayers according to their own religion, as well as to meet people of a different faith.

The interfaith room is located inside the Rettoria (entrance from the garden, piazza Sraffa 6): climb the stairs, turn to right. The interfaith room is the first room on the left. It is opened from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. from Monday through Friday, just as all the study rooms available to students.
